



Innovative Classroom Projects

Application Criteria

The Pasco Education Foundation Innovative Classroom Projects are intended to enhance classroom instruction. All applications must address school and district goals, in addition to the Florida Standards and/or school improvement plans. These projects should encourage higher standards that challenge and motivate our students.

Instructional materials funded by these grants become the property of the school/department in which the employee is employed when applying.

A. Innovative Classroom Projects may be funded to include:

1. Classroom materials, program supplies, books, special equipment, etc. for "special" classroom projects
2. Computer software/hardware
3. iPads, iPods, Nooks, Kindles, tablets, Printers
4. special considerations deemed appropriate by the selection committee

B. Innovative Classroom Projects will not be funded for the following:

1. Books that could be funded by the school's book budget (In special cases some books will be funded if the books needed are to enhance a special project or program)
2. T-Shirts or clothing for projects
3. Bus Transportation or field trips
4. Advertising
5. Receptions or parties at schools (food, beverage, entertainment, decorative or promotional items)
6. Computers, Cell phones, PDA's
7. Travel
8. Those items not listed that are deemed inappropriate by the review committee

C. In all cases, the decision to approve a request for allocation will be based upon the grant's likelihood of improving student performance and/or having the greatest impact on students. Projects will be evaluated by the selection committee for the impact and potential success of the program.

All Innovative Classroom Project Applications are Due no later than Sunday, October 8th.

Final Evaluation forms must be submitted at the end of your project or no later than May 1, 2018.
